DVD instructions:

When you put in the DVD, an Explorer window will pop up. (If it does not pop up, open the Explorer file called index.htm)

Install ArcReader first.

Then you will be able to click on the hypertext in the Explorer window to view each map.

The DVD also contains a PDF of the Shoreline Inventory and Characterization document. This document is not linked to the Explorer window—you will have to open it from your DVD drive.

Hardware Requirements for ArcReader and the maps:

Operating System: Windows 2000 or newer

If you are running Linux or Solaris you can download ESRI ArcReader©© and view the hardware requirements on the [ESRI ArcReader©© download page](#).

CPU Speed: 800 MHz minimum recommended or higher

Processor: Intel Pentium or Intel Xeon Processors

Memory/RAM:

For viewing 2D map documents:

- 256 MB minimum, 512 MB recommended

DVD ROM Drive

For viewing 3D globe documents:

- 512 MB minimum, 1 GB recommended

Display Color: Greater than 256 color depth

Disk Space: Typical 213 MB NTFS, Complete 225 MB NTFS

Disk Space Requirements:

- In addition, up to 50 MB of disk space maybe needed in the Windows System directory (typically C:\Windows\System32). You can view the disk space requirement for each of the 9.1 components in the Setup program.
