

**CHAPTER 2.76
FIREMEN'S CIVIL SERVICE**

- 2.76.010 Moses Lake Civil Service System: Pursuant to the authority conferred upon the City of Moses Lake by RCW Chapter 41.08, there is recreated a Civil Service System, which will have rules and/or regulations which substantially accomplish the purposes of RCW Chapter 41.08 concerning among other things but not limited to the selection, appointment, and employment of individuals in the Fire Department of the city, except for the position of Fire Chief, which is excluded by the authority contained in RCW 41.08.050 and specifically excepting positions in the Fire Department including but not limited to secretaries, clerks, and the like. - 2.76.020 Composition: Such Commission shall be composed of three (3) members, who shall be appointed by the City Manager and who shall serve without compensation. Such Commissioners shall have the qualifications as prescribed by RCW 41.08.030. The term of a member who ceases to reside within the corporate limits of the city shall terminate.
- 2.76.030 Duties: This Civil Service Commission, upon appointment, qualification, and organization, shall hold meetings, perform duties and adopt rules and/or regulations which substantially accomplish the purpose of RCW Chapter 41.08 for covered fire fighters and specifically excepting the position of Fire Chief and all other positions including but not limited to secretaries, clerks, and the like. This Commission is specifically granted the authority and power in the place and stead of the City Council to adopt and enforce its rules and/or regulations which substantially accomplish the purpose of RCW Chapter 41.08 which is in the best interests of the city.
