- 3.10.010 Findings: The City of Moses Lake stated its intent to establish the Park and Recreation Improvement Fund with the passage of Ordinance No. 1526 on July 14, 1992. It is desired to further establish and define the purpose of the Park and Recreation Improvement Fund. (Ord. 1530, 1992)
- 3.10.020 Purpose: The Park and Recreation Improvement Fund shall receive funds intended to be expended for the improvement of park and recreation facilities in the City of Moses Lake. The funds shall be used to acquire land and facilities and to renovate or build new facilities which are or will be included in the city's park system or related to the city's recreational programs, whatever they may be. (Ord. 1530, 1992)
- 3.10.030 Revenues and expenditures: The revenues accruing to the fund and the expenditures charged against the fund shall be set forth in the annual budget or in budget amendments as adopted by the City Council. (Ord. 1530, 1992)
