3.11.010 Findings:

A. The City of Moses Lake established the Central Services Fund with Resolution #1151 on March 8, 1983.

B. It is desired to further establish and define the operations of the Central Services Fund. (Ord. 1498, 1991)

3.11.020 Services to be Provided: As an internal service fund, the Central Services Fund shall be used to provide data processing and word processing services to all city funds and departments and to acquire, service, repair, maintain, operate, and replace personal computers, computer software, copiers, telephone systems, office supplies, and other electronic equipment and services for all city funds and departments as deemed necessary and appropriate for the City of Moses Lake. The fund shall operate under the Washington State Budget, Accounting, and Reporting System (BARS) and Governmental Generally Accepted Accounting Principals guidelines for internal service funds. (Ord. 1498, 1991)

3.11.030 Taxes and Charges: The taxes, charges, and rates for the fund's operation are to be generally set forth for each department in the annual budget as adopted by the City Council. (Ord. 1498, 1991)
