PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT USE FEES**

- 3.34.010 Fees Established: The following use fees shall be established by the City Council after having been reviewed and a recommendation received from the Park and Recreation Advisory Commission:
- A. Family Aquatic Center Admission Fees, Swim Lesson Fees, and all other fees related to the use of the Moses Lake Family Aquatic Center.
 - B. All fees related to the use of Larson Playfield and Paul Lauzier Athletic Complex.
 - C. Cascade Park Camping Fees
 - D. Fees for all other programs not designated as pay-as-you-go programs (Ord. 2107, 1/14/03; Ord. 1970, 11/14/00; Ord. 1881, 12/14/99; Ord. 1052, 1982)
- 3.34.020 Pay-As-You-Go Programs: The use fees for all pay-as-you-go programs shall be established by the Park and Recreation Advisory Commission pursuant to this grant of authority from the City Council. A pay-as-you-go program is a program defined as one which is solely supported by fees generated from the participants. The fees for pay-as-you-go programs as set by the Park and Recreation Advisory Commission shall be no less than the amount necessary to conduct the operation of the program. Any fees set by the Park and Recreation Advisory Commission for a pay-as-you-go program may be reviewed by the City Council on the City Council's motion. (Ord. 2490, 7/28/09; Ord. 1052, 1982)
